UNIVEG's office and farm are located in Buín, 40 kms south of Santiago de Chile in the Maipo Valley.

ACTIVITIES

Chile is the leading supplier of fresh fruit from the Southern Hemisphere and accounts for 60% of the Southern Hemisphere fruit exports. The main products in the UNIVEG Chile portfolio in fresh fruits are grapes, apples, kiwis, citrus, stone fruit, avocados, cherries and blueberries. UNIVEG Chile supplies also dry fruits, mainly walnuts and almonds.

- UNIVEG is sourcing and exporting fruits from local growers, exporter companies and own farm production, only to UNIVEG companies.
- Different initiatives and partnerships in sourcing have been undertaken in order to secure residue-free fruit from certified growers.
