UNIVEG started investing in South Africa in 2000 and established production units. As from May 2006 a separate division managed and co-ordinated the activities in South Africa which had grown substantially. In 2008 the UNIVEG group purchased Katopé International who also had a footprint in South Africa. The two operations with various offices were merged to create a new all encompassing structure in South Africa.

Today UNIVEG Export South Africa, based in Stellenbosch, Western Cape, handles all the marketing of deciduous, citrus fruit and persimmons in South Africa for the UNIVEG group.

Working closely with the other divisions UNIVEG Katopé South Africa and UNIVEG Services South Africa we continuously use the scale benefits of the South African operations to the optimized advantage of our business partners.
